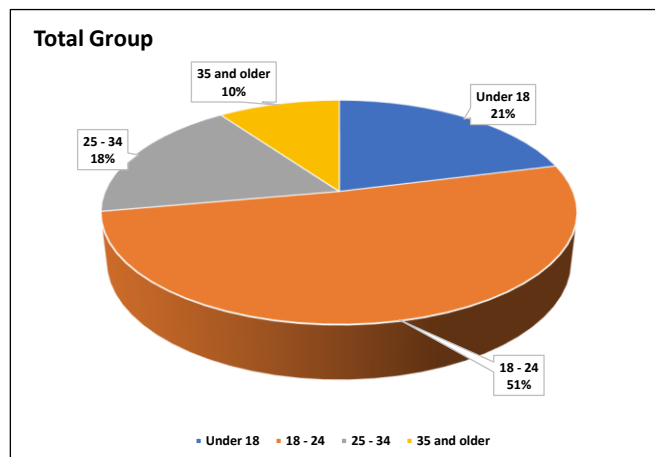

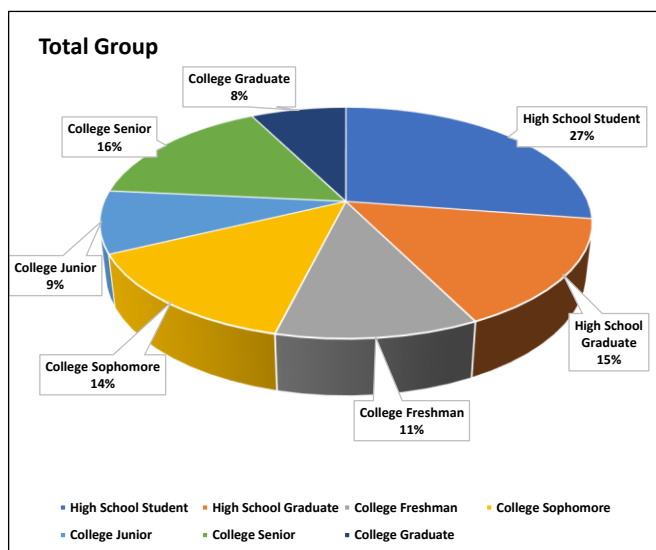

#### All Candidates by Education Level<sup>6</sup>



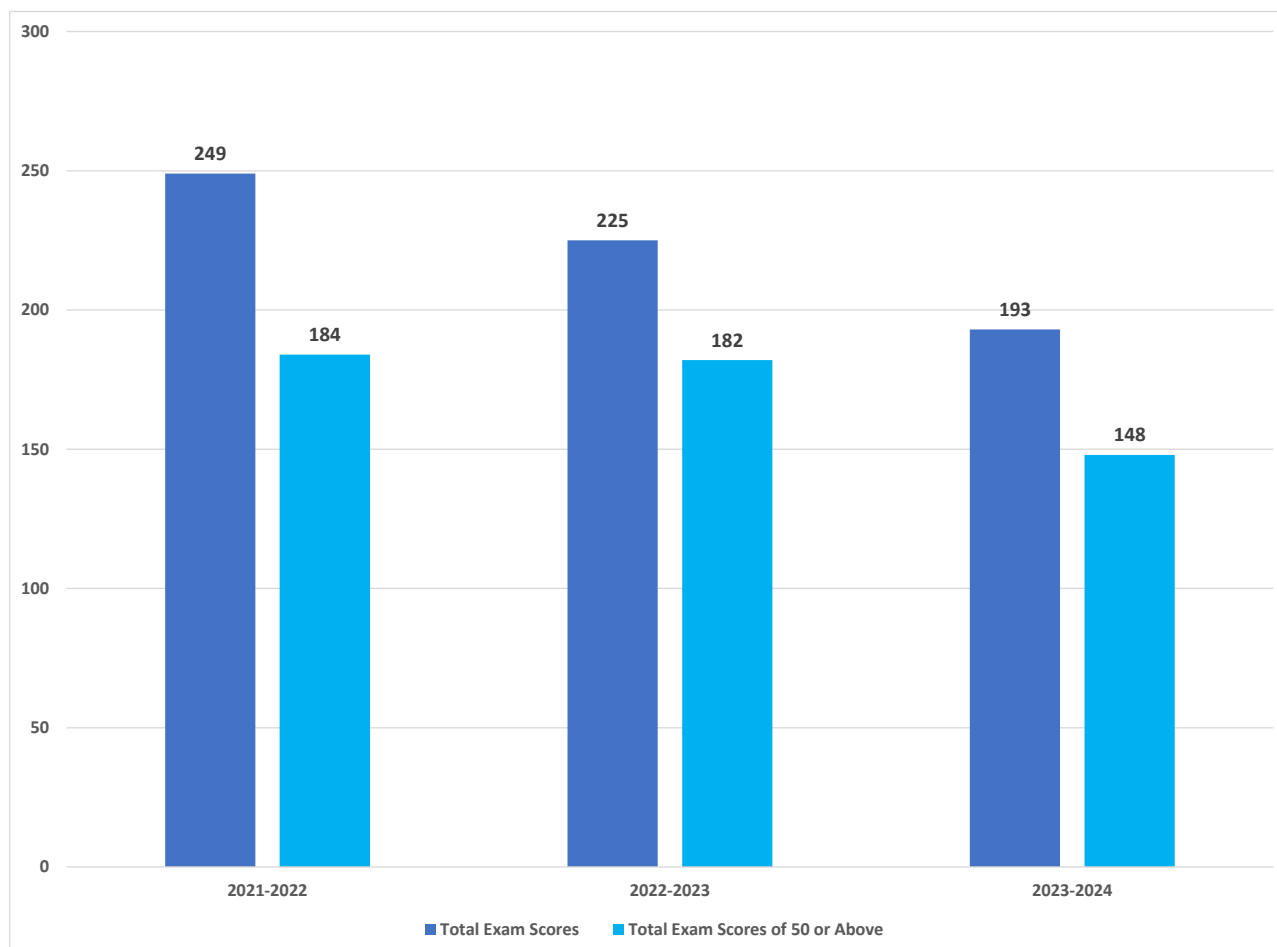
