Subject: Program Alignment Status at a Glance

Listed below is a brief update on the status of program alignment activities.

Healthcare Documentation and Transcription Specialist – The Kansas Board of Regents (KBOR) approved the alignment map for the Healthcare Documentation and Transcription Specialist (formerly Medical Transcriptionist) program on Thursday, November 12, 2012. The alignment map and related components have been posted to the KBOR website. All colleges offering the Healthcare Documentation and Transcription Specialist program are granted one year (January 2014) to implement the alignment.

HVAC – After reviewing alternate credentialing options with Business and Industry experts the State Curriculum Committee has reconvened to finalize the proposed alignment map. Final adoption is expected during the fall semester with required committee, Technical Education Authority, and KBOR approvals in early 2013.

Phase I activity is being initiated for the following programs:

Electrical Technology (CIP 46.0302)

Diesel Technology (CIP 47.0605)

Industrial Machinery Mechanics (CIP 47.0303)

Computer Support Specialist (CIP 11.1006)
