



HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENTS AY2013 - AY2018




HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENTS AY2019 - AY2024






High School Enrollment by Credit Hours All Courses for Unduplicated All Students Academic Years 2019 - 2024 Systemwide Summary

SECTORS PROVIDING HIGH SCHOOL ENROLLMENT CREDIT HOURS






PERCENTAGE OF CREDIT HOURS EARNED BY RACE/ETHNICITY
