



General Use Operating Expenditures by Program Percent of Total Fiscal Year 2019 - 2024







- 2. There was a large increase in the General Use Auxiliary Enterprise category from FY 2021 to FY 2022. This increase was largely from Kansas State University, who attributed the increase to a more normal year of operations for the Childhood Development Center.

- 3. In recent years, University of Kansas Medical Center's housestaff positions had been almost exclusively funded from non-general use funds. The majority of their housestaff positions are funded from the Graduate Medical Education Reimbursement fund (2918-3050) which is now funded from the restricted fee fund.
 - a. For FY 2018, this specifically affects the Housestaff FTE amount for Table E, which will now be zero.
 - b. For FY 2019, the University of Kansas Medical Center lists two Housestaff positions funded from general use funds.
 - c. For FY 2020, the University of Kansas Medical Center lists 2.9 Housestaff positions funded from general use funds.
 - d. For FY 2021, the University of Kansas Medical Center does not reflect any Housestaff positions funded from general use funds.
 - e. For FY 2022, since no corresponding expenses were reported, 1.8 FTE Housestaff positions have been reported as part of classified FTE positions.
- 4. In FY 2021, the University of Kansas Medical Center began utilizing a new payroll system, which resulted in university support staff being reported as part of the unclassified staff.

- 6. The 2024 State University data book reflected an error. The "Other Operating Expenditures" amount was overstated by \$15,864,201 (the amount of the utilities expenditures for the year).
