



Age of Program Completers As Reported 2014-2015















Summary

- 96% Overall institutional growth 2008-2015
- 28 new SARA institutions
- 13% decrease in student enrollment growth 2008-2015
- 21,918 Awards completed in 2014-2015
- 139,907 awards completed from 2010 2015
 *74% certificate/diploma
 *26% degree
- Complaints continue to decrease
 - (-10% in 2014, -78% since 2008)
