Supporter Level

At least one opportunity:

- Participates in career fairs (colleges, workforce, community)

- Serves on advisory committees

<u>Partner Level</u>

Recognize Industry Credentials or Partners for Success Endorsement in hiring process + two additional opportunities

- Assists education delivery by providing needed resources
- Provides professional development for faculty
- Provides additional resources for program/students
- Assists program with instructional delivery
- Engage with students through resume feedback and mock interviews
- Assists with program design

<u>Champion Level</u>

Recognize Industry Credentials + two additional opportunities

- Provides paid/unpaid internships for students or faculty
- Interviews students prior to completion
- Refers job applicants lacking basic skills or high school diploma to adult education programs
- Provides professional development and industry certifications for instructors
- Advocate for adult education in the community
- Utilizes adult education programs for incumbent worker training (academic skill development, GED, ESL, employment and cognitive skill development)
- Provides scholarships for students (GED testing and/or tuition assistance)
